Humble us that we totally depend on You, Dear Father.</p>	<p>6 Pray through Psalm 67. Pray about God's intention to bring redemptive blessing to every people so that He may redeem a people from every people. Pray about your role in this...your church's role.</p>	<p>7 Pray that you might clearly understand the difference of being "in church" and being "the church." Pray that God will reveal to you those things that hinder your growth to spiritual maturity.</p>	<p>8 Dear Lord, show us the reality of our need and the reality of Your answer to that need.
