## Scholarship Application Instructions and Additional Information

The Mutual Aid Society will award up to \$10,000 in the spring of 2024. The amount of each scholarship will depend on the number of qualified applications received. Candidates must be high school seniors or undergraduate students who will be attending an accredited university, college or technical school during the summer or fall following the award of scholarship funds. Past recipients may apply again; however, preferential consideration will be given to first-time applicants.

Payment can be made directly to the school, or the recipient may choose to be reimbursed. If the recipient chooses to be reimbursed, a statement/receipt verifying payment for tuition, fees and/or books must be provided to the Mutual Aid Society Administrative Board before reimbursement can be made.

**THE APPLICATION ON THE REVERSE MUST BE COMPLETED ENTIRELY AND ALL APPROPRIATE SIGNATURES OBTAINED.**

The **essay** must be 3-5 pages in length, typed and double-spaced using a 12 pt font and one-inch margins. The subject of the essay must be one of the following three topics, AND **MUST include information on how you plan to remain active in or see yourself involved in Mutual Aid:**

- The history of either the Mutual Aid Society of the Unity of the Brethren, or the Unity of the Brethren, or both.
- The motto of The Unity of the Brethren is "In Essentials, Unity; In Non-Essentials, Liberty; In All Things, Love". What do you understand this to mean?
- The motto of the Mutual Aid Society is "Bear ye one another's burdens and so fulfill the law of Christ" (Gal. 6:2). What do you understand this to mean and how does it impact your life?

The application must be postmarked by **March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024**.

An electronic copy of the **essay must be emailed** by **March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024** to Rev. Joseph Polasek at josephjpolasek@yahoo.com.

Interviews may be conducted during April by the Scholarship Selection Committee, which will be made up of Mutual Aid Society members. If necessary, a committee member will contact you to arrange an interview.
